- To participate in extended Canadian wilderness canoe trips and canoe trips of up to 21 days in length, covering as many as 75-200 miles. Trip Heads are 21 years of age or older. Staff are trained in water rescue, Wilderness First Aid or higher and CPR. There are “safety valves” along all canoe routes that provide access to emergency assistance and each trip unit carries a satellite phone that can be used to summon help in an emergency. Even with these precautions there could be times on a trip when darkness or bad weather makes it impossible for an aircraft to reach a trip group or distance makes it impossible to get someone to professional medical care in fewer than 18 hours.
- To participate in mountain trips of up to 14 days in 21 days in length that take place in the Western United States. At least one staff member is 21 years of age or older and at least one is trained in Wilderness First Aid and CPR. There are “safety valves” along all canoe routes that provide access to emergency assistance and each trip unit carries a satellite phone that can be used to summon help in an emergency. Even with these precautions there could be times on a trip when darkness or bad weather makes it impossible for an aircraft to reach a trip group or distance makes it impossible to get someone to professional medical care in fewer than 18 hours.
- To participate as part of a supervised group at Ogichi Daa Kwe’s base camp, or Deer Island, Kooch-i-ching’s base camp, in “tubing”, waterskiing, various “sports”, archery, riflery, woodworking, top rope climbing, low and high ropes course, crafts, sailing, yoga, minor building and construction which may include power tools, fire-building, cooking, axe and saw use, and/or the other daily program offerings.
- At Kooch-i-ching only, participate in projects class and the voluntary honor service organizations and their initiations which may involve the use of power tools.
- To be transported in camp-designated vehicles (including, if necessary, light aircraft) for a wilderness trip, a field trip, routine medical treatment and/or a medical emergency.
